

3. Resolution 010818-A Authorize Lease Purchase Agreement for Fire Department Pumper Truck

Council Member **Farrell** introduced in the form of a motion, **Resolution 010818-A**, authorizing the Lease Purchase of a Pumper Truck for the Fire Department in the amount of \$483,521.04.
