

Having previously been introduced at the September 25, 2017 council meeting, Council Member Rokestraw moved the adoption of the following Ordinance, which was seconded by Council Member Bedsole:



ORDINANCE NO. 171009-047

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 34-9(b) OF THE ALABASTER CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING GARBAGE COLLECTION FEES

Section 1. Section 34-9(b) of the Alabaster Code of Ordinances (2015) is hereby amended as follows:


Sec. 34-9(b). -.

The fees for such collection shall be paid monthly in advance and shall be in the amount of \$15.27 for residential customers plus one half the residential rate for each additional cart, and \$30.54 for business or other non-residential customers for the first 2 carts, and an additional one half the business rate for each additional cart as of January 1, 2018. No business or non-residential customers shall have more than 4 carts. Beginning in January, 2019 the fee shall be adjusted annually utilizing the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All Items Less Food and Energy. The fee shall be collected for each single-family residence or mobile home not in a mobile home park, and multifamily residences, and each business or other nonresidential establishment that is not otherwise serviced by a dumpster. Mobile home parks and apartment complexes shall be serviced by dumpsters or other acceptable means that are not serviced by the city.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law, provided, that no penalties shall be assessed any property prior to January 1, 2018.
