PRESS RELEASE

Due to Governor Ivy proclaiming a state of emergency, confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Montgomery and Jefferson Counties, and statewide school closings, the City of Alabaster will also take the following precautionary measures for the health and safety of our residents:

- Spring sports will be delayed until April 6th, at which time leadership will re-evaluate the climate and concerns surrounding COVID-19. This means all organized park activities will cease immediately. Our Park and Recreation Department will be available to answer any questions for program sport participants and coaches.
- The Library will be closed to the public until April 6th.
- The Dog Park will be closed until April 6th.
- All Senior Center trips scheduled will be cancelled until further notice. Since our Seniors are considered the most vulnerable and at-risk population, we do not want to take any chances with their health and well-being. We will continue to evaluate the risks associated with normal Senior Center activities and make adjustments as needed.

City Hall, Park & Recreation, Public Works, and Environmental Services offices will operate within normal business hours. City staff will be available to serve our customers in all areas, except for those services mentioned above. Please do not hesitate to call 205-664-6800 with any questions or concerns. As a reminder, all non-emergency public safety concerns should be directed to 205-663-7401.

Alabaster City Council Meetings will continue with their normal schedule—first and third Mondays. Work Sessions are posted as soon as they are set.
