

## COVID-19 SIGNS / SYMPTOMS

### PROTOCOL POLICY FOR PARTICIPANTS AND PARENTS

The City of Alabaster takes reasonable caution for participants within the City's activities and events. The following guidelines are in place for participants and/or family member(s) of a participant in relation to City related events and activities:

#### Participant Screenings:

- All participants, coaches and volunteers should monitor his/her temperature independently. In the event of a temperature of 100.4 at any time, the individual is not eligible to maintain current activity and should isolate from the program until cleared to return or has been fever free for a period of 24 hours with no medication.

#### Response to Exposure / Testing Positive:

- If a participant, coach and/or volunteer of any City related activity or event has direct exposure (Close Contact), which is defined by the CDC as someone that has a confirmed COVID-19 case, for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more and less than 6 feet apart without a face mask (2 days prior to test specimen collection) **OR** the participant should test positive for COVID-19, he/she may not participate in any City related activity or event for a period of:
  - o Vaccinated individuals = 10 days
  - o Un-vaccinated individuals = 14 days

Upon completion of the mandatory quarantine days and with no new or worsening symptoms and no fever for a period of 24 hours with no medication, the participant may return to stated activity or event.

#### Face Coverings:

- As a protective measure for City activities and events, face coverings are recommended but not required at this time for those in areas that cannot meet the 6-foot social distancing guidelines to include participants, coaches and volunteers of stated programs. Spectators are encouraged, but not required, to wear coverings and ensure social distancing as much as possible.
- Face Covering requirements may change at any time based on policy and will be communicated at that time by Park management.

These guidelines are in place for the participant, coaches and/or volunteers within the City event or activity. These guidelines are to protect the potential exposure and transmission of COVID-19 to the best of our ability, and your cooperation is appreciated. If you should have questions or concerns, please see a member of management.
